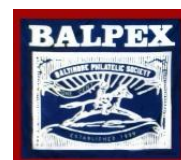


## Calendar Third Quarter 2026

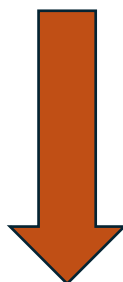
